K-9 Conservation provides logistical backup and support to conservation areas and game parks through the deployment of elite, highly trained and specialized, working dog units. We fight against any form of poaching but specialise in fighting against Rhino poachers in particular due to the ever growing threat.

Our handlers and dogs are carefully selected and paired to maximize efficiency and effectiveness, while non-stop on-the-job training ensures our units are continually rated top class.

Canine Conservation has had many successes over the years with the dogs. Last year alone, one of our units apprehended two known rhino poachers and brought down their syndicate operations. Thanks to the dogs and their handlers these two poachers, who were responsible for over 20 rhino's deaths, are now convicted and behind bars.

On our current contracted area we have experienced a huge reduction in rhino poaching and illegal incursions from poachers. For over a year our area has remained clear from poaching and illegal activity, whilst the neighboring properties without canine capability have lost over 20 rhinos in the same time period.
